

BWA Web Information Notice

How we treat your details.

The protection and security of your personal data are important to us. Therefore, any personal data collected by us will be with your knowledge and consent. Here we wish to outline what information we record and for what purposes this information is used.

What information do we collect from you and for what purposes?

When you access this website only details of your visit are collected, including your IP address (your computer's individual identification number for internet connection), date and time of visit are automatically logged by our web server and kept for a period of four weeks for data security purposes only (e.g. in order to identify and trace any persons gaining or attempting to gain unauthorised access to the web server).

We will treat with strictest confidence any personal details sent when you access our web pages in accordance with UK data protection legislation. By sending us an e-mail or completing and submitting the online forms on our website you are consenting to us using your personal data (which could extend to your name, address, phone number and e-mail address) for the following purposes:

- To enquire about membership or further information about the Blackwater Wildfowlers Association

Your personal data will not be passed on to third parties outside the Blackwater Wildfowlers Association except to our web service and hosting providers..

In order to enhance the content and functionality of our internet pages, we also keep statistical information (e.g. the number of visitors to each website and how long they stayed there, internet provider, browser type). The information is recorded on our behalf by an external service provider but the information is used for internal purposes only and does not allow individuals to be identified.

Cookies

For technical reasons, we use session cookies on our website, which are stored on your hard disk for the duration of the link. We also use session cookies to retrace usage behaviour in anonymised form. The anonymised usage data is recorded, processed and used only in order to gear our website to users' needs. These session cookies are not used to collect any personal information about you. Session cookies are automatically deleted as soon as you leave our website or the dialog is ended. When using our internet services, you can decide whether you wish to accept or decline these cookies by modifying the settings in your browser. If session cookies are disabled on your browser, however, you may not be able to use certain features or sections of our website.
